

VENUE VISUAL GUIDE

NATIONAL THEATRE OF SCOTLAND

I am going to see a show at Corn Exchange, Market Square, Melrose TD6 9PN.



This is the Corn Exchange where the performance will be taking place.



This is the main entrance. I will walk through these doors to enter the venue.

The entrance is wheelchair accessible.



When I walk inside I will see this area called the Foyer.

There will be staff who can help with any questions about the event. It might be quite busy and noisy with other members of the audience.

I can buy or collect tickets at the reception desk.



Auditorium/ Performance space: I will watch the show in this space.

The lights will dim when the show is ready to start, and the actors will come on to the stage. The actors won't be able to talk directly to me during the play. They will be in character. I will need to be quiet while watching the show.



There are toilets available at the venue including an accessible toilet.

Toilets are located behind the seating bank in the auditorium.

I can ask a member of staff for directions at any point.



If I find sounds or lights disturbing during the show, I can ask a member of staff for earplugs, ear defenders or dark glasses at any time.

I will need to return these after the performance.



If I would like to take some time out during the play I may leave at any time and take a break in the Chill Out Space until I am ready to go back in.

The Chill Out space will be marked with this sign. I can also ask a member of staff for directions.



At the end of the show the audience will clap to show the actors that they enjoyed the show.

When the clapping has ended, the lights will get brighter. This means the show is over.

I can now leave the theatre.

I should exit back through the way I came in.
