

VENUE VISUAL GUIDE



LYTH ARTS CENTRE

I am going to see a show at Lyth Arts Centre, Lyth,
Wick KW1 4UD.



This is Lyth Arts Centre where the performance will
be taking place.



When I walk inside I will see this area called the
Foyer.

There will be staff who can help with any
questions about the event. It might be quite busy
and noisy with other members of the audience.



There is a Bar/Cafe where I can buy drinks and snacks before the show begins. I can also take a seat here and relax while I am waiting.

To find it, I should walk into the Foyer and turn right.



There are toilets available on the ground floor. I can find them opposite the main entrance, straight across the Foyer.

I can ask a member of staff for directions at any time.



Auditorium/ Performance space:

I will watch the performance in this room. An usher can help me find a seat.

When the show is ready to start, the lights will dim and the actors will come out onto the stage. During the show, they may interact with the audience. I will need to be quiet while watching the show.



If I am disturbed by any noises or lights, I can request earplugs, ear defenders and dark glasses at the Box Office. I will have to return them after the play finishes.



At the end of the show the audience will clap to show the actors that they enjoyed the show.

When the clapping has ended, the lights will get brighter. This means the show is over.

I can now leave the theatre.

I should exit back through the way I came in.
