


VENUE VISUAL GUIDE

SUMMERHALL

I am going to see a show in the Dissection Room, 1, Summerhall, Newington, Edinburgh EH9 1PL.

The main entrance to the venue has 9 steps with no railing. If I need step free access I can follow this guide.



This is the entrance to the courtyard to the right-hand side of the building on Summerhall Square.



I should cross this courtyard.



When I see these doors I should turn left onto the access ramp.



This is the access ramp.



I need to keep going along this path past the bar. I can get a drink here if I would like.



At the end of the ramp I will turn left and go through this door.



I will turn left and go along this corridor.



I will then arrive at the reception where I can ask a member of the front of house team to help me to my seat.



When I am ready I can use this lift to get to the show space. I only need to go up 1 floor. There are also stairs if I would prefer to use those.



I need to go along this corridor towards the gallery space which currently contains various sized metal spiders as part of an art exhibition in the building.



I need to go through this door on the other side of the room.



I will watch the performance in this room.

An usher can help me find a seat and I will need to show them my ticket when I enter.

When the show is ready to start, the lights will dim when the show is ready to start and the actor will come out onto the stage.



At the end of the show the audience will clap to show the actors that they enjoyed the show.

When the clapping has ended, the lights will get brighter. This means the show is over.

I can now leave the theatre.

I should exit through the foyer.
