

VISUAL GUIDE FOR NATIONAL THEATRE OF SCOTLAND AT ROCKVILLA



I am going to the National Theatre of Scotland at Rockvilla, 125 Craighall Road, Glasgow, G4 9TL.



Rockvilla is located on the Forth and Clyde canal in the north side of Glasgow.

Rockvilla is well served by local buses, the subway (Cowcaddens is a 10-minute walk away) and main line trains (Central Station and Queen Street Stations – are a 25-minute walk away).

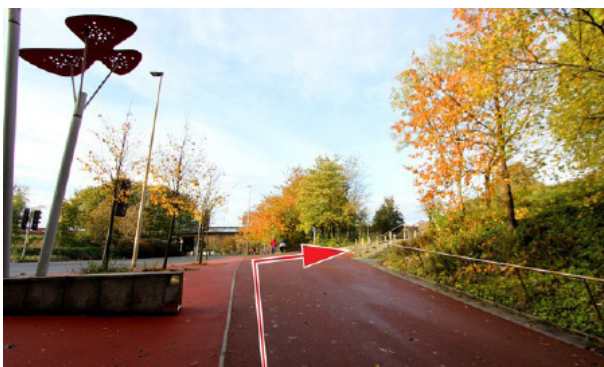
It can also be accessed by car from Craighall Road.



If I am arriving by car, I should enter from Craighall Road. There is a vehicle ramp signposted by two temporary banners and a roadside AA signage.

The car park includes two Blue Badge spaces closest to the entrance.

If I cannot find a space in the main car park, there is an overflow carpark to the left of the main car park.



If I am arriving by subway, I should exit at the Cowcaddens Subway Station and walk towards Garscube Road.

With the Dundas Court flats on my right, I should walk under the motorway underpass until I reach the stairs on my right.



I will climb the stairs or use the ramp beside them, then continue on the right-hand path until I reach a longer staircase on my left that looks like this.



I will continue to climb to the top of the steps, or use the cycling path until I reach the canal.

I should keep to the left bank of the canal opposite the Spiers Wharf residential block and carry on down the canal. There is no through access past the flats on the right bank.



I will walk towards the pedestrian bridge near the power pylon. I will then cross the bridge and turn left. I will see a grey building with the National Theatre of Scotland logo at the top.

To enter, I will use the entrance at the front of the building to the left of the car park.



This is the Rockvilla entrance. There are double automatic doors with level access into reception.



I will have to ring the doorbell for access. I should press the button with the bell icon on the panel.

I will find the panel on the wall straight in front of the doors or on the right hand side as I approach the entrance.

ROCKVILLA: GROUND FLOOR



This is the reception area. If there is an event on at Rockvilla, it may be decorated differently.

There will be reception staff as I come in, who I can talk to if I have any questions.



When I arrive I will be asked to sign in on a touch pad. I will find it to the right of the reception desk.

We ask everyone to sign themselves in and out every time they arrive or leave.

If I need some help using the touch pad, I can ask staff at the reception desk to assist me.



If I want to relax or if I am waiting for someone, I can use this area in front of the reception.

I can use the sofas, chairs and tables here.



There are two kitchens on the ground floor.

The first kitchen is on the left hand side of the reception desk as I enter the building.

Each kitchen is equipped with a fridge for storing lunch, cutlery, cups, plates, and bowls, as well as a sink, a hot water dispenser, a microwave, and a dishwasher.

This kitchen is convenient if I am waiting at the reception or staying in the Front Room.



This is the second ground floor kitchen. It leads directly to the atrium and will be convenient to use if I am in the Big Room, the Back Room, or the Play Room.

This kitchen is equipped with a stove, allowing me to cook my own food using pots and pans from the kitchen cupboards. The drawers of both ground floor kitchens will be labeled so that I can find everything I need.

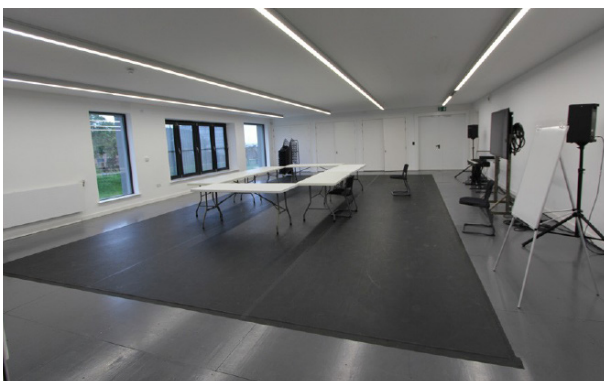


If I need to use a bin, I should check whether my rubbish is recyclable according to the items listed on each bin. If I am not sure, I should use the general waste bin.



This is the entrance to the Front Room.

It is located to the left as I enter the building near the sofas and seats at the reception area.

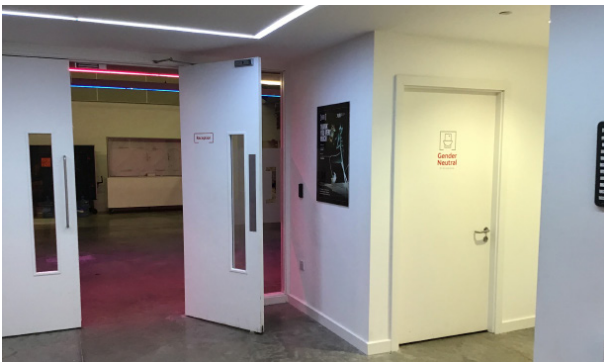


This is the Front Room. It may look different and have bits of set or props when I come to visit.



The area to the right of the reception desk leads to the atrium, the main space at Rockvilla.

From the atrium, I can access the offices upstairs or the Big Room, the Back Room, and the Play Room on the ground floor. To enter the atrium, I will walk through these double doors.

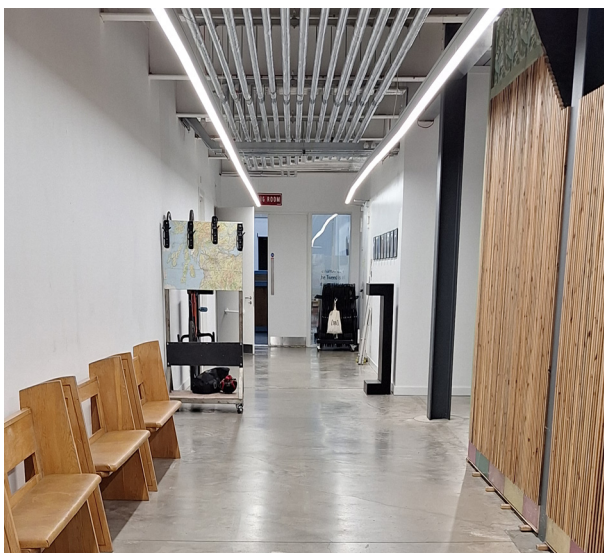


To the right of the atrium doors, I will find gender-neutral toilets including an accessible toilet.



From time to time, I may hear a loud beep, which happens when someone swipes a card to access one of the secured rooms.

While this is a normal occurrence and should not cause alarm, it might be uncomfortable if I am sensitive to loud sounds.



This is the atrium, the main space at Rockvilla.

If there is an event on, there may be lots of people and the decorations and lighting may be different.

The Big Room and additional toilets are located down the corridor to the left.

The Back Room and the Play Room are straight ahead as I come through the doors from reception.



There are tables, chairs and sofas in the Atrium. I can sit here to relax, hold a meeting, or eat my lunch.

I must be careful not to be too loud, as noise travels upwards and the people in the office may hear me.



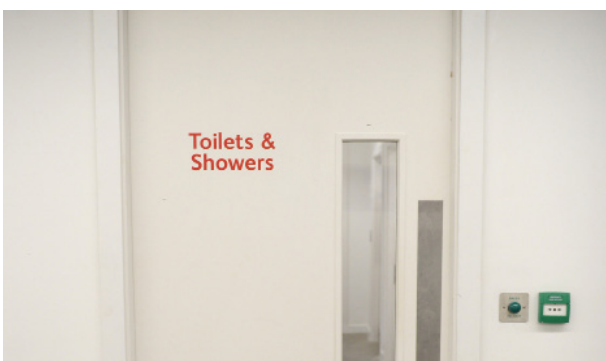
If I am heading to the Big Room, I should walk across the entire corridor to my left after entering the atrium. I will find the door marked "Big Room" with a sign above it.

There is a gender-neutral accessible toilet immediately to the left of the entrance to the Big Room.



This is the Big Room. It may look different and have bits of set and props, or even a stage when I come to visit.

It may be busy and have lots of people in it, as well as music and lights if there is an event on.



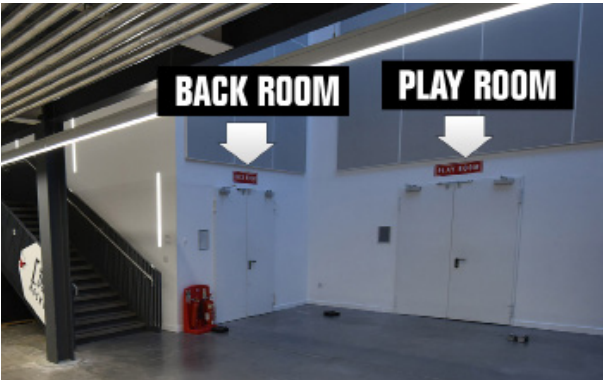
To the left of the accessible toilet by the Big Room, there are showers and more toilets. The door to access them looks like this.



If I go through the door marked "Toilets & Showers" I will enter this corridor. There will be toilets with urinals and cubicles or just cubicles to my left, and showers to my right.

All showers and toilets are gender neutral.

This corridor also leads to the Front Room. If I want to reach it, I should use the door at the very back.



The Play Room and the Back Room are located in the atrium by the main staircase as shown in this image.



This is the Play Room. I will find it straight in front of me when I enter the atrium from the reception. The sign above the door will say "Play Room."

It may look different and have bits of set and props, or even a stage when I come to visit.



This is the Back Room, located to the left of the Play Room. The sign above the door will say "Back Room"

The Back Room may look different and have bits of set and props, or even a stage when I come to visit.



If I would like to take some time out and relax, I can use the Quiet Space under the main staircase.

I will need to walk across the corridor toward the Big Room and turn right as I approach a table with chairs.



I should first check if anyone is in the room. The bar to left of the door will be red and say "In use" if the room is occupied.

If the bar is green and says "Vacant" like in this image, it means the Quiet Space is available and I can enter.



To turn on the lights in the Quiet Space, I should use the light switch on the wall to the left, under the sign that says "Please turn the Quiet Space lights off when not in use." I should turn off the lights when I am no longer using the Quiet Space.



This is what the Quiet Space looks like from the inside. I can adjust the height of the desk on the left. I can also take a seat or lie down on the sofas at the back of the room, and there is a curtain I can draw for more privacy.

If any features of the room are unclear, the reception staff will be happy to assist me at any point.



I can use this panel to adjust the warmth of both the overhead and floor lights. If I encounter any issues, the reception staff can assist me.

The panel is located in the middle of the room and will be straight in front of me when I enter.



This is the Laundry and Dye Room. I can find it behind the Atrium shelves.



This is the Costume Workshop. I can find it to the right of the Laundry and Dye Room and past the Packing Area.
